SUMMARY

Boston is one of the largest retail markets in the United States, with 967 deals closed in the past 12 months. That was a material increase compared to the five-year average sales count. Annual sales volume has averaged \$1.8 billion over the past five years, and the 12-month high in investment volume hit \$3.3 billion over that stretch. In the past 12 months specifically, \$3.0 billion worth of retail assets sold. Deals involving general retail steered annual sales volume, accounting for \$1.6 billion of the metro's sum in the past 12 months.

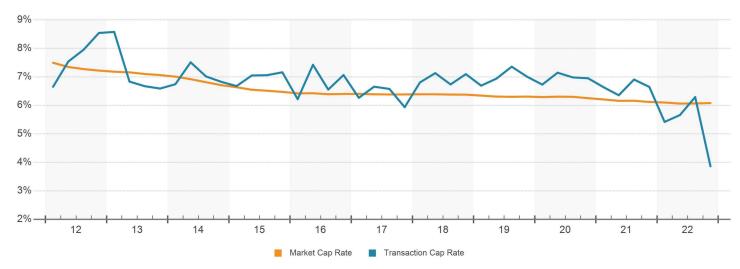
Market pricing, derived from the estimated price movement of all retail properties in the region, sat at \$268/SF during the fourth quarter of 2022. That figure is an improvement over this time last year, and that price comes in above the country's average. The 6.1% market cap rate is only a few basis points lower than last year's number, and the rate in the metro is structurally lower than those across the country.



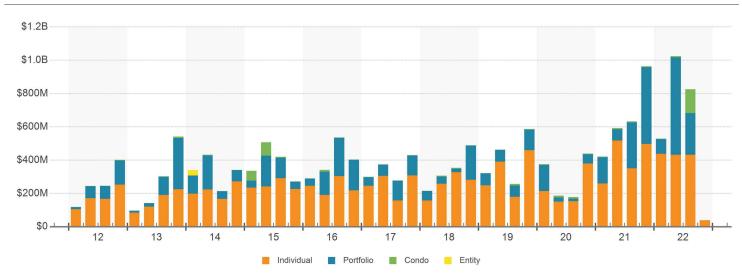
MARKET SALE PRICE & TRANSACTION SALE PRICE PER SF



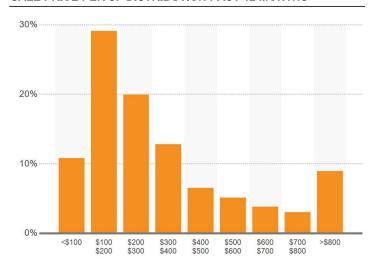

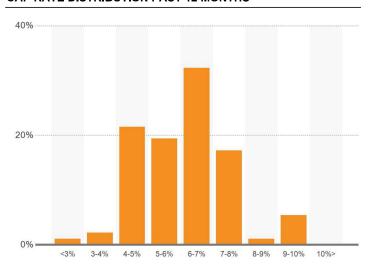
SALES VOLUME BY TRANSACTION TYPE



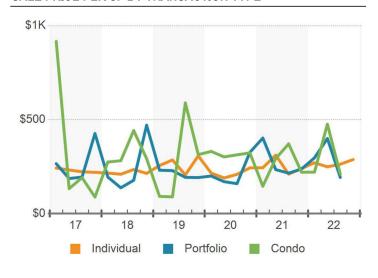
SALE PRICE PER SF DISTRIBUTION PAST 12 MONTHS



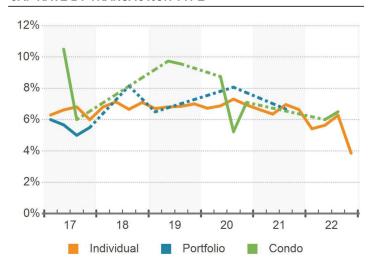

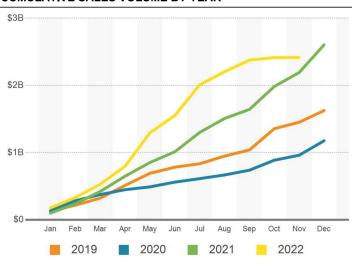

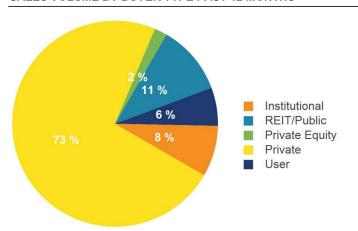
CUMULATIVE SALES VOLUME BY YEAR



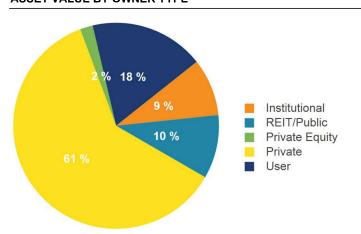

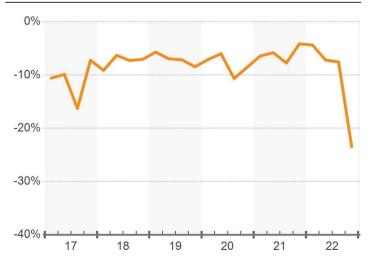

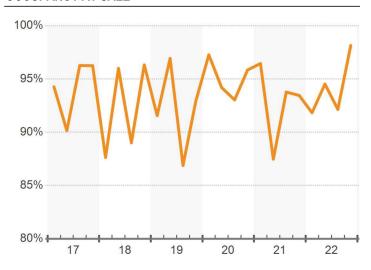

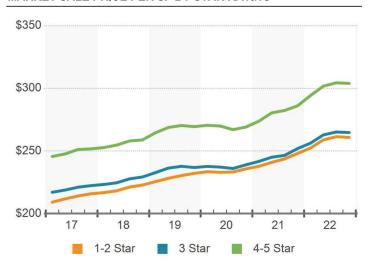

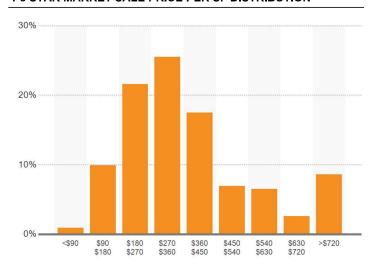

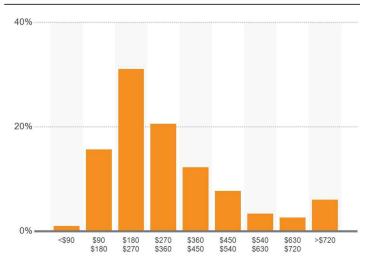

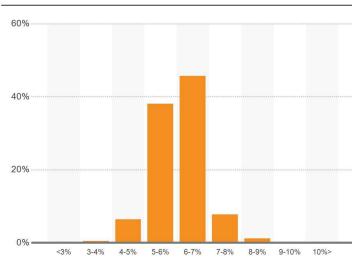

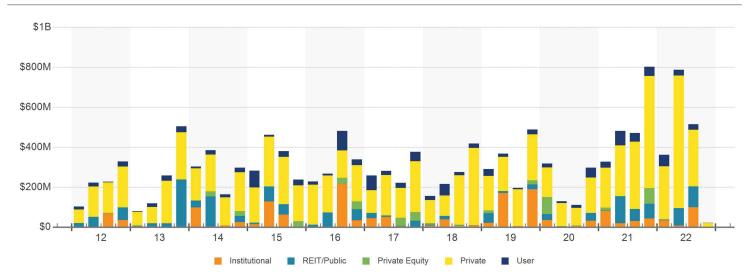

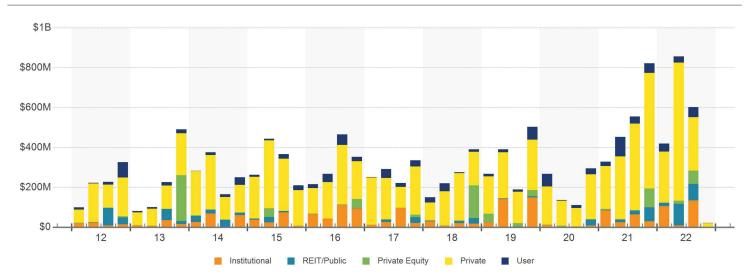

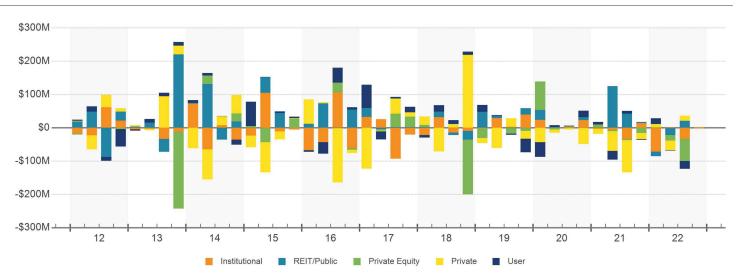
SALES VOLUME BY BUYER TYPE

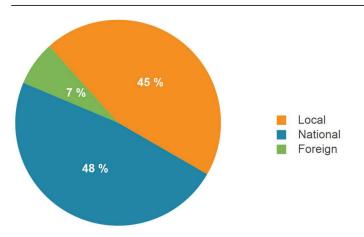


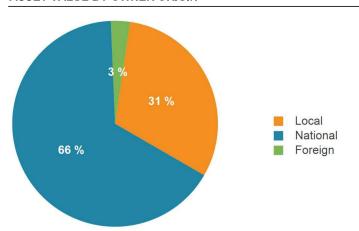
NET BUYING & SELLING BY OWNER TYPE

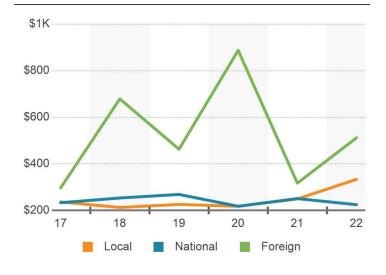


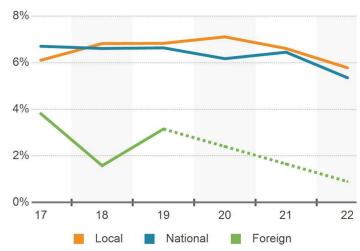
